## State Historical Marker designation for the Leelanau County Poor Farm and Poor Farm Barn

State Historical Marker Dedication Scheduled!

This marker honors the Leelanau County Poor Farm and the Poor Farm Barn. The Michigan Historical Marker Program was established by the legislature and governor in 1955. Since then, more than 1,700 Michigan Historical Markers have been placed all across the state—and in several other states and Europe—making Michigan's one of the premier marker programs in the nation.

Each marker reflects important stories of place, event/s or people noting the importance a community places on its heritage and serving as a signpost of historical significance. A marker dedication ceremony is an event of commemoration and celebration that introduces a lasting area resource for tourism, education and heritage.

The Leelanau County Historic Preservation society is a 501 (c) (3) nonprofit community and educational organization facilitating the preservation and rehabilitation of historic structures in Leelanau County, MI.
